

# January Block of the Month

## MONKEY WRENCH TIMES 2

**COLORS** - Use two different colored batiks - one for color A and one for Color B  
Background should be a batik neutral

**CUTTING** - Cut one 2 1/2" square of background color  
Cut two 3" squares of background color  
Cut two 3" squares of color A  
Cut the 3" squares in half, giving you four triangles of each  
Cut one strip 1 1/2" x 12" from background and one from color A

Cut two 4" squares from background  
Cut two 4" squares from color B  
Cut squares in half for four triangles of each  
Cut one strip 2" x 28" from background and one from color B\*

\*Keep in mind that these pieces will be sub-cut so you can work with smaller pieces if you don't have a 28" strip.

### SEWING;

- 1 - Sew background triangles to color triangles - square up to 2 1/2:" - press to dark
- 2 - Sew strips together-press to dark - cut into four 2 1/2" segments
- 3 - Sew together as shown in Diagram A
- 4 - Sew background and color B triangles together as before - trip to 3 1/2"
- 5 - Sew strips together and cut into four 6 1/2" segments - should measure 3 1/2 x 6 1/2
- 6 - Sew according to Diagram B

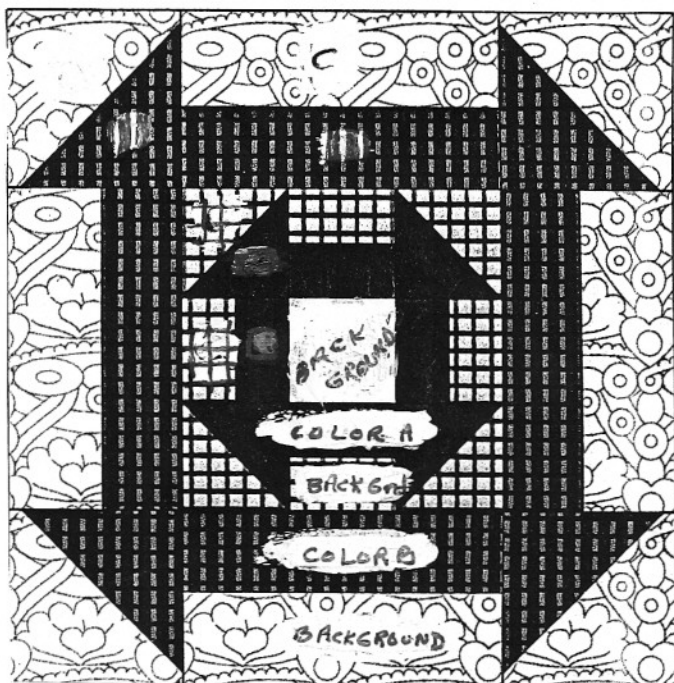

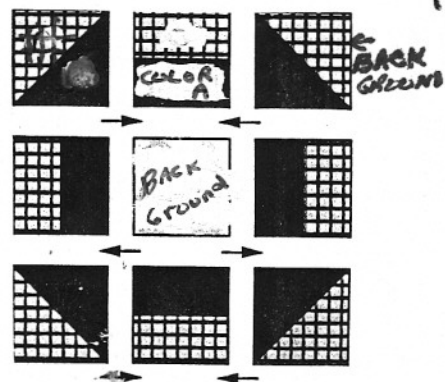
