CONSTRUCTION OF OLD SNOWFLAKE BLOCK

1. Sew muslin B to each side of blue strip A. Repeat for each of the remaining corner squares.
2. To make the hourglass square, sew 1 blue & 1 muslin C together on the short side to make one half of the square. Make a second square, reversing the color placement, & sew the two half squares together. Repeat process to complete the four hourglass squares.

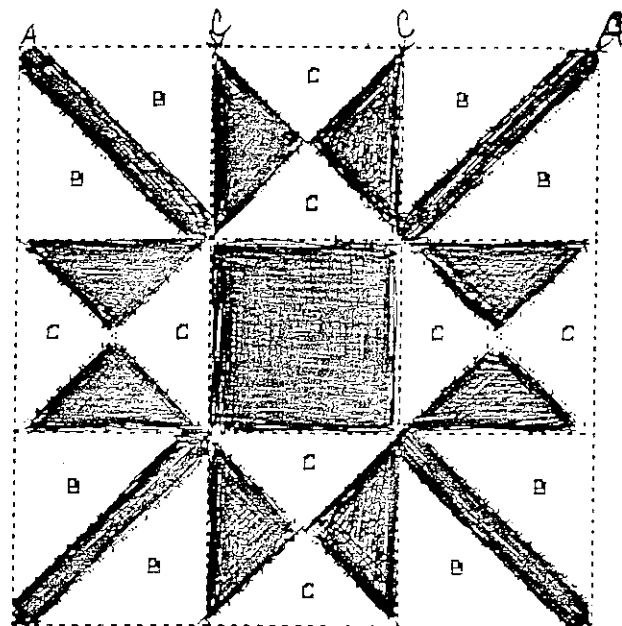
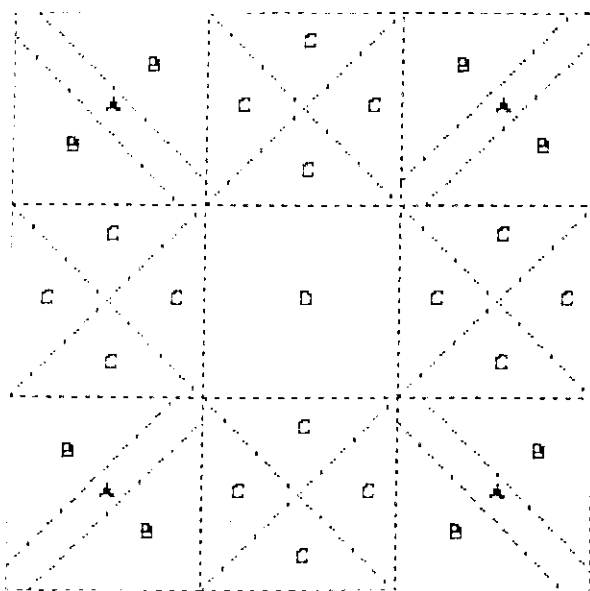
ASSEMBLING THE BLOCK

- Row 1 Join an A/B square to each side of one of the hourglass squares.
- Row 2 Join an hourglass square to each side of D. Join to row 1.
- Row 3 Repeat row 1, making sure the A/B square is reversed. Attach to the bottom of row 2.

COLORS: BRIGHT BLUE AND MUSLIN

SUZE: 12 1/2 inches unfinished

1. Cut 4 A's in blue
2. Cut 8 B's in muslin
3. Cut 8 C's in blue and muslin
4. Cut 1 D in blue
