Block Two

Judy's Star

from 1998/1999

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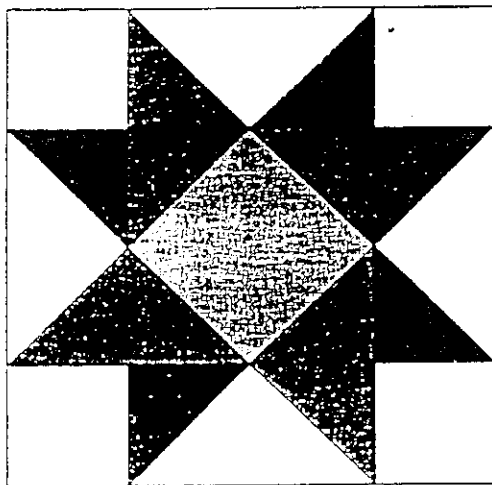
* We will use cotton - not flannel

What could be better for this month than a snuggly, warm flannel quilt! So try this pretty star block in flannels. We'll use a solid flannel for the background, your choice of a medium to large floral or plaid flannel for the center section, a medium flannel for the small star points, and a dark for the large star points.

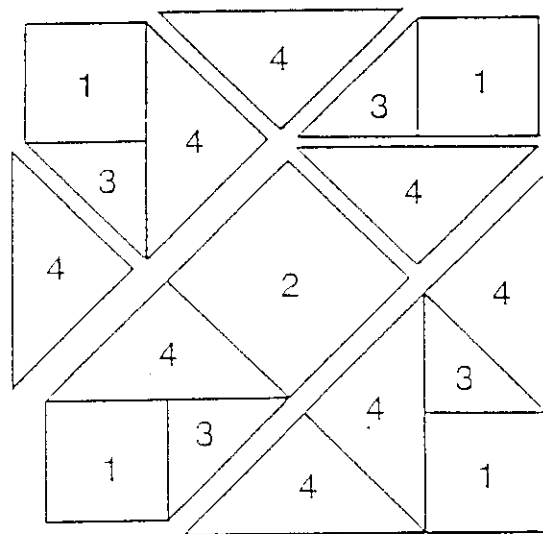
Mix and match flannels in florals, small prints, plaids or stripes but be sure the background is solid.

Due to the real possibility of shrinkage with flannel, please be sure to prewash all fabrics for this block.

- Cut:
- Piece 1: four 3 1/2" squares background
 - Piece 2: one 4 3/4" square medium to large floral for the center.
 - Piece 3: two 3 7/8" squares medium tone. Cut each in half once diagonally to make 4 triangles for the small star points.
 - Piece 4: two 5 1/8" squares solid background. Cut each in half diagonally once. You will have four triangles.
 - Piece 4: two 5 1/8" squares dark flannel. Cut each in half diagonally to make four triangles for large star points.
