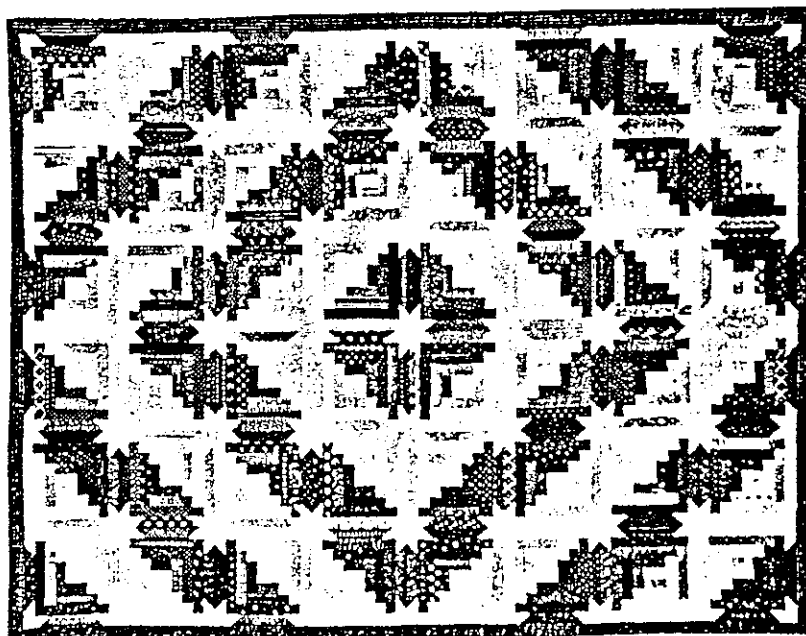
- Cut one of each strip - includes seam allowance of 1/4"
- Begin at center with 2 1/2" Traditional Red square and sew first Light piece (A) to center. Follow the attached diagram for piecing sequence (in alphabetical order).

Light
 A = 1 3/4" x 2 1/2"] LT.
 B = 1 3/4" x 3 3/4"] same fabric
 C = 1 3/4" x 5"] LT.
 D = 1 3/4" x 6 1/4"] same fabric
 E = 1 3/4" x 7 1/2"] LT.
 F = 1 3/4" x 8 3/4"] same fabric

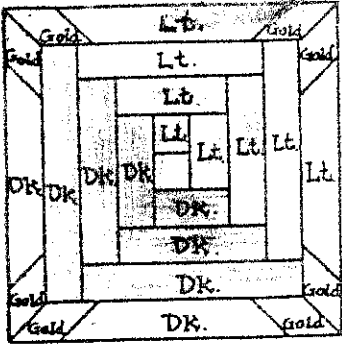
Dark
 B = 1 3/4" x 3 3/4"] DK.
 C = 1 3/4" x 5"] same fabric scraps
 D = 1 3/4" x 6 1/4"] DK.
 E = 1 3/4" x 7 1/2"] same fabric scraps
 F = 1 3/4" x 8 3/4"] DK.
 G = 1 3/4" x 10"] same fabric scraps

I = See template; cut 2 from same fabric
LT. scraps

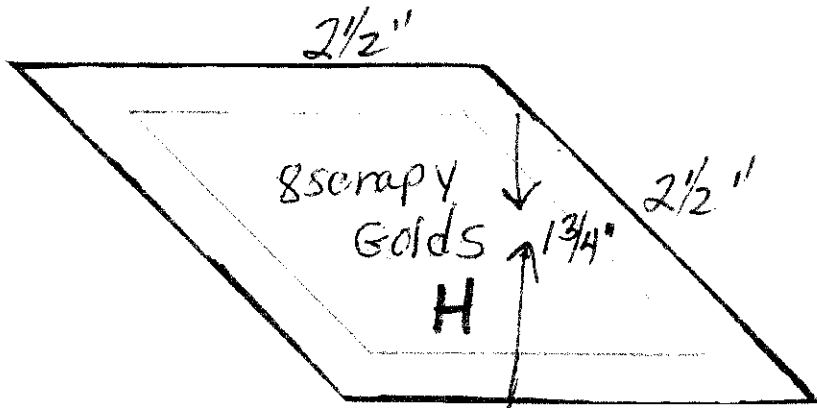
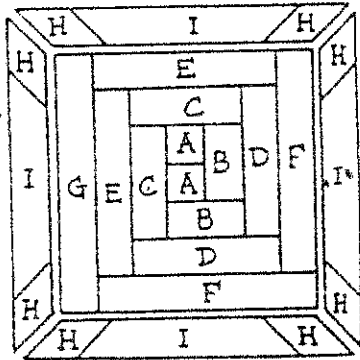
