This Block was taken from
the year 2003/2004

we have a 12" finished block comprised of four six-inch
anvil blocks. There are many ways to piece this block. Since we are
only doing half-square triangle blocks we will do one of the easiest.

Choose four *scrap* fabrics and a *off white* for the background. You
will make four of these six-inch blocks, one with each of the *scrap*
block fabrics and the background.

For each six inch block make:

1. Two half-square triangle blocks that will finish to 3"
(unfinished 3 1/2") using the main fabric and the
background.
2. Four 1 1/2" finished (unfinished 2") half-square triangle
blocks of the main fabric and background.
3. Four 2" squares of the background.

Assemble each unit as per diagram. Assemble the four units into the
12" block. Be careful and note the direction of each subunit.
