Finger Lakes Log Cabin – Clamshell Quilt Guild 2016 Raffle Quilt

The Raffle Quilt Committee met for the first time in January of 2015. The committee was comprised of the following members: Jane Barth, Jayne Coale, Jean Conway, Pat Cosgrove, Terry Donati, Joan Folcik, Karen Partington, Kim Rennie, Gail Staehle, and Tara Thornton. The group considered several quilt patterns. The finalist was a quilt from Judy Martin's Log Cabin Quilt Book, and permission was granted from Judy Martin to use her Finger Lakes Log Cabin pattern. In keeping with the character of our shoreline guild, we selected 36 different batik fabrics to give the feeling of sea glass.

The Finger Lakes Log Cabin, based on traditional double wedding ring and log cabin designs, is made from over 5000 square and rectangle pieces. There are 225 blocks of various sizes that complete this 93" x 93" queen/king size quilt. Next, it was machine quilted by Holly Potvin at Bear Hallow Quilt Company. Holly used a custom altered pattern by the original designer, Tammy Finkler Oberlin of TK Quilting and Design.

Raffle tickets will be for sale from August 16, 2015 through August 16, 2016 at various venues, participating quilt shops and from Guild members. The winning ticket will be drawn at the Clamshell Quilt Guild August 2016 monthly meeting held at Temple Emanu-El in Waterford, CT.

Proceeds from the sale of the raffle tickets will be designated for the Women and Girls Fund/Community Foundation of Eastern CT. and the Educational fund of the Clamshell Quilt Guild.
