Yellow with white print  $(3) 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares Color A


(3) 1 \(\frac{7}{8}\)" squares

Color B Medium purple print (2) 4 ½" squares

(3) 1 \(\frac{7}{8}\)" squares

Color C White with yellow print  $(3) 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares

(3) 1\%" squares






Piece the small 17/8" squares (3 from each color) as shown. This will be the center square in the nine patch. Trim to 4 ½" if necessary.



Sew the squares into 3 rows as shown, then sew the rows together to make a 12 ½" block (12" finished).







This quilt was made using 12 blocks in a 3 x 4 grid. With a 1" inner border and a 5" outer border the finished size is 48" x 61".
