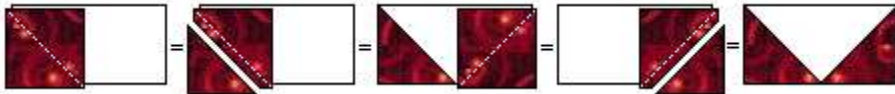


White	Two 4" squares Four 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles
Nautical print	One 6-1/2" square
Red	Eight 3-1/2" squares
Dark blue	Two 4" squares

1-Half-square triangle units: Stack the White 4" square and Dk blue 4" square, right sides together. On the back of the top square, mark a diagonal line and stitch a scant 1/4" above and below the marked diagonal. Cut apart on the marked line and press seam towards the blue fabric. Trim unit to measure 3-1/2". Repeat to make a total of 4 half-square triangles.

2-Flying geese units - Stack a Red 3-1/2" square on the right lower corner of a White 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle, right sides together. On the back of the red square, mark a diagonal line and stitch on the marked diagonal. Cut off the excess seam allowance. Press seam allowance towards Red fabric. Repeat on left lower corner of white rectangle. Make 4 flying geese (3-1/2" x 6-1/2") units.



3- Assemble blocks into rows using the block diagram as a guide. Rows 1 and 3: Half-square triangle + flying geese + Half-square triangle. Row 2: Flying geese + Center 6-1/2" square nautical print + Flying geese. Press seams in alternating directions.

4- Sew rows together to complete the block. The block should measure 12-1/2" square.
