
BOX KITE

Bright yellow print (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square Color A

(2) 4 \%" squares

Dark forest green print (2) 4 1/8" squares Color B

Color C White on white (4) 4 \(\frac{7}{8}\)" squares




Mark a diagonal line on the back of the (4) white 4 1/8" squares. Pair these, right sides together with the (2) 4 1/8" color A and (2) 4 1/8"







color B squares. Sew 1/4" on both sides of the marked line and cut apart on the line to make (4) half-square triangle units of colors A and C and (4) of colors B and C.



Lay out the squares as shown. Sew into 3 horizontal row, then join the rows together to make a 12 ½" block (12" finished).





This quilt was made using 14 blocks. Alternate blocks were rotated to make pattern. The quilt finishes at 59" square, using a 1" inner border and a 4" outer border.
