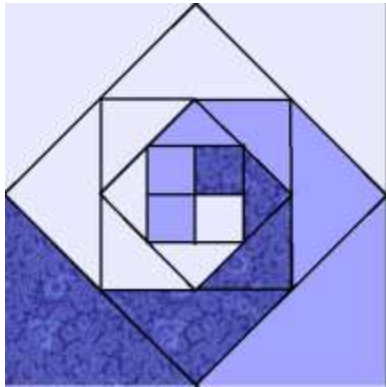


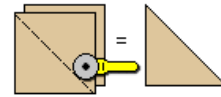
AUGUST 2018 BOM

WIND AND WAVES



From each fabric - Cream, Med blue, and Dark blue cut the following:

- (Piece A) One 7" square, cut diagonally once
- (Piece B) One 5" square, cut diagonally once
- (Piece C) One 4" square, cut diagonally once
- (Piece D) One 3" square, cut diagonally once



- Cream One 2" square
- Dark blue One 2" square
- Med blue One 2" x 3-1/2" rectangle



1-Starting in the center: sew Cream 2" square to Dk blue 2" square. Press. Sew Med blue 2" x 3-1/2" rectangle to this unit (this unit should measure 3-1/2" square). Watch the orientation! With Dk blue square at top, sew Med blue piece on left side.

Use a scant 1/4 " seam (one or two threads less than 1/4 "). Work clockwise and press away from the center after each seam. TIP: Lightly finger press center of triangle and match this to middle of center unit.

2-Sew Med blue (D) to center block; then Dk blue (D), then Light blue (D), and Light blue (D) on last edge. Trim this unit to measure 4-3/4" square.

3- Sew Med blue (C) to unit from step 2; then Dk blue (C), then Light blue (C), and Light blue (C) on last edge. Trim this unit to measure 6-1/2" square.

4- Sew Med blue (B) to unit from step 3; then Dk blue (B); then Light blue (B), and Light blue (B) on last edge. Trim this unit to measure 9" square.

5- Sew Med blue (A) to unit from step 4; then Dk blue (A); then Light blue (A), and Light blue (A) on last edge. Trim this unit to measure 12-1/2" square. Your block is complete!
