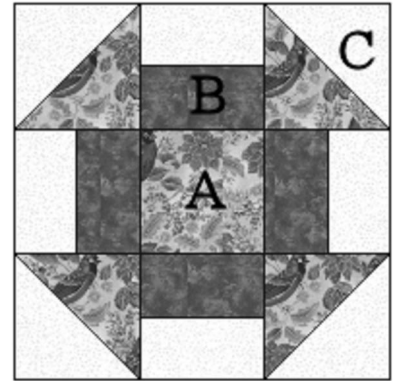

CHURN DASH

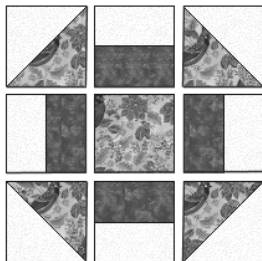
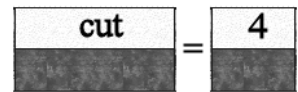
- Color A Red, green, & gold print (1) 4 1/2" square
(2) 4 7/8" squares
- Color B Mottled green print (1) 2 1/2" x 19" strip
- Color C Off white/cream print (2) 4 7/8" squares
(1) 2 1/2" x 19" strip



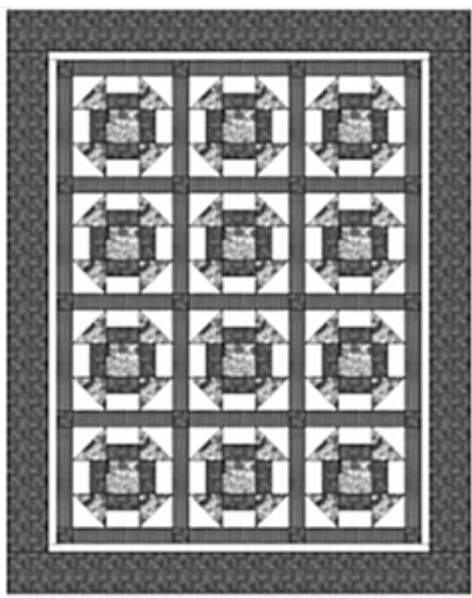
Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the (2) Color C 4 7/8" squares. Put right sides together with the (2) Color A squares. Sew 1/4" either side of the drawn line. Cut along pencil line and press open to make (4) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares.



Sew the 2 1/2" x 19" strips of Colors B and C together; cut into (4) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares.



Assemble into 3 rows as shown and then sew the rows together to make a 12 1/2" block (12" finished).



This quilt was made using 12 blocks in a 3 x 4 grid. Quilt measures 56" x 70" using 2" sashing, a 1" inner border and a 5" outer border.
