

December Friendship Star Make four 6½" block (6" finished size)

Make the star with red or green fabric on a white background

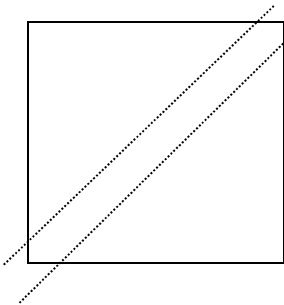


From white background
cut sixteen 2 ½" squares
cut eight 3" squares
From red or green fabric
cut four 2 ½" square
cut eight 3" squares

Make Sixteen Half Square Triangles (four for each block)

Use the eight 3" squares of background fabric and the eight 3" squares of red or green fabric

Use a ruler to mark ¼" from each side of the center diagonal on the wrong side of the background fabric (or mark the center diagonal and sew ¼" away on each side of your marked line)



Layer each square of background fabric with a square of red or green fabric, right sides together.

Sew on marked lines.

Cut on center diagonal between stitched lines.

Press seam toward the darker fabric.

Square up to make sixteen 2½" half square triangle units

Layout squares and half square triangles to create one star blocks as show below. Sew together each row. Press seams toward the squares. Pin to match the points to sew the rows together. Repeat with remaining squares to make a total of four 6 ½" unfinished sized blocks.
