



Dark blue	One 13" square
Blue for water	One 14" square
Fusible web	One 13" square

Make a copy of the whale pattern. Using a light box or window, turn the pattern over and trace along the pattern edges for the reverse whale pattern.

Use your favorite appliqué method to prepare the whale appliqué pieces. If hand appliquéing, then add approximately 1/8" along the edges for turning. If using fusible, trace whale and reversed whale on paper backed fusible web, and cut on pattern lines. Finish by stitching around the edges of the appliqué (satin, zig-zag, or blanket stitch).

Lightly press blue water fabric in half vertically and horizontally for guide lines. Center whale and reversed whale on vertical line as indicated on the pattern. The top whale should be approximately 3/4 inch above the horizontal center line at the center vertical crease, and the bottom reversed whale should be approximately 2 inches below the horizontal center line at the center vertical crease. Applique the whales to background.

Press square and trim to measure 12-1/2" square. Add white buttons for eyes.
