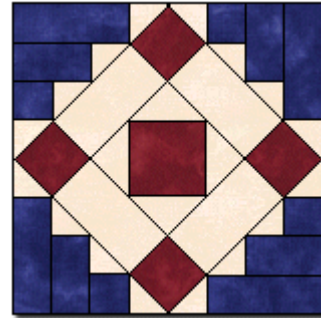


July - Old Glorious

Red- Four $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch squares

One $3\frac{1}{2}$ inch square



White- Four $2\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$ inch rectangles

One $4\frac{1}{4}$ inch square cut in half on the diagonal both ways to make 4 Quarter square triangles

Eight $2\frac{3}{8}$ inch squares cut in half to make 16 Half square triangles

Blue- Four 2 inch X 5 inch rectangles

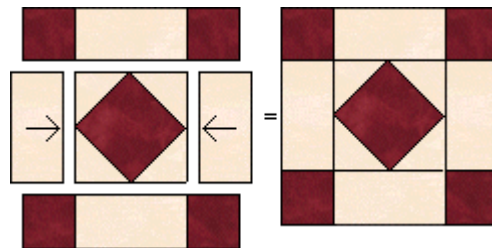
Four 2 inch X $3\frac{1}{2}$ inch rectangles

Four 2 inch squares

- 1) Sew White QSTs to opposing sides of the Red $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square, pressing seams towards the corner triangles. Then sew the last two White QSTs to the adjacent sides of the center square, again pressing towards the corners



- 2) Sew the Red squares to the ends of two White rectangles, pressing seams towards the rectangles. Next, sew the remaining White rectangles to the left and right edges of the center Square-in-Square unit, pressing seams again towards the rectangles. Add the square-plus-rectangle units to the top and bottom edges, pressing seams towards the top and bottom

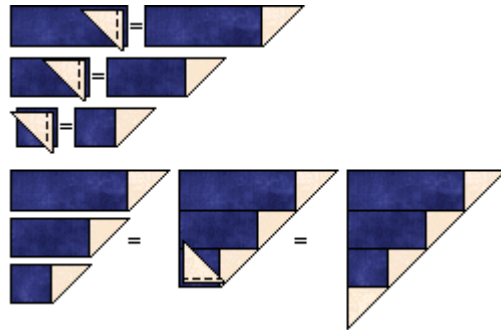


3) Sew a White HST to the right edge of each Blue 2" x 5" rectangle, pressing seam towards the rectangle.

Sew a White HST to the right edge of each Blue 2" x 3-1/2" rectangle, again pressing towards the rectangle.

Sew the last four White QSTs to the right edge of each Blue 2" squares, pressing towards the squares.

Now join those units as shown at left to make four Corner units for the block.



4) Sew Corner units to opposing sides of the blocks Center unit, and then add the last two corners to the adjacent sides
