

DOUBLE Z


Color A Dark green print	(6) 3 ⁷ / ₈ " squares
Color B White on white	(8) 3 ⁷ / ₈ " squares

Color C Medium to light green print (2) $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " squares




Draw a diagonal line on the back of the (8) $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " white blocks. Pair these, right sides together, with the (6) $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " color A and the (2) $3 \frac{7}{8}$ "

color C squares. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on both sides of the marked line and cut apart on the line to make (12) half-square triangle units of colors B and A, and 4 half-square triangle units of colors B and C.



Lay out the half-square triangle units as shown, using the 4 light green print/white print half-square triangle units in the center (forming a pinwheel). Sew the rows together to make a $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " block (12" finished).



This quilt was made using 12 blocks in a $3 \ge 4$ grid. With a 1" inner border and a 5" outer border it measures 48" ≥ 60 ".
