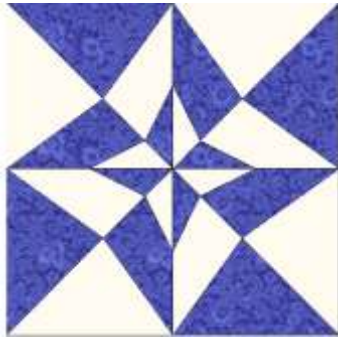


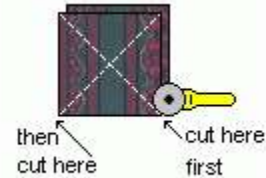
MARCH 2018 BOM

NORTH STAR



Dark blue (should read as solid) Four 2" x 4" rectangles (piece # 3R)
(Approx. 1/3 yd)

Four 3" x 6-1/2" rectangles (piece # 2)
One 12-1/2" square (piece # 1R)
Cut diagonally 2X (4 pieces)

(Approx. 1/3 yd)

Four 2" x 4" rectangles (piece # 1)
Four 3" x 6-1/2" rectangles (piece # 2R)
One 12-1/2" square (piece # 3)
Cut diagonally 2X (4 pieces)

Make 4 copies of the pattern pieces. Paper specifically made for paper piecing is easier to use. Double check to make sure the copies measure 6-1/2" as shown on the pattern. Use your favorite paper piecing method to construct 4 Part A and 4 Part B pieces.

Construction: Press all seams open. Join 1 Part A to 1 Part B on the side A seam to make 4 blocks (each block will be 6-1/2" square). Using block diagram as a guide, layout blocks to make the star pattern. Sew the 4 units together on side B to form a 12-1/2" square.
