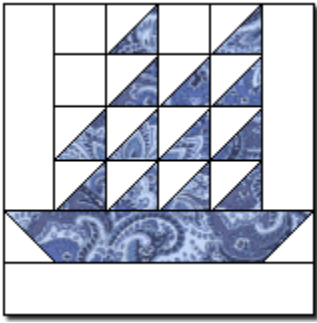


## May - Tall Ship



### Cutting Instructions

#### White

One 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" strip

Two 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips

Five 2-1/2" squares

Seven 3" squares

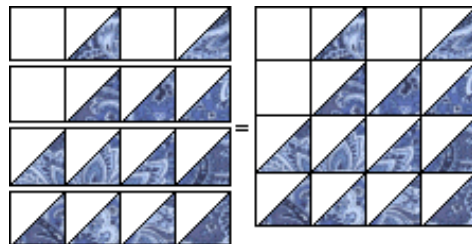
#### Blue

Seven 3" squares

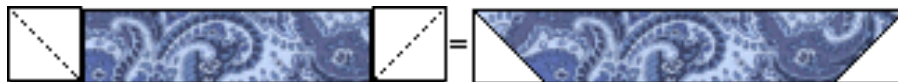
One 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" strip

**Step 1.** Stack the blue and white 3" squares in pairs and draw in the diagonal on the back of the top square. Stitch 1/4" away on both sides of the drawn line. Cut apart on the drawn line. Press to dark sides Trim to 2-1/2". You will have one extra as you only need 13

**Step 2.** Next, using the half squares we just made and three of the 2-1/2" White squares, construct the four rows shown and sew them together to make the block's center.



**Step 3.** Place the remaining two White squares right sides together against the ends of the Blue 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" strip, with edges aligned. Draw in the diagonals as shown and stitch ON the drawn line. Cut off the excess corner, pressing the remaining 1/4" towards the triangles



**Step 4.** Sew the two White 8-1/2" strips to the sides of the center unit. Sew the White 12-1/2" strip to the bottom of the boat unit. Add the boat unit to the top part
