

AMISH DIAMONDS


Color A	Bright solid	 (1) 6 ¹/₂" square (4) 3 ¹/₂" x 6 ¹/₂" rectangles
Color B	Black solid	 (8) 3 ¹/₂" squares (mark 4 of these on the diagonal)






Place a black $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square, right sides together, lined up with the upper left corner of the bright solid $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Mark the diagonal and sew in the direction shown. Trim off excess seam allowance and press the remainder

towards the center square corner. Now sew another $3\frac{1}{2}$ black square to the opposing corner in the same way, and then to the two adjacent corners. Square to $6\frac{1}{2}$.



Piece the block as shown. Make rows first and then join rows to make the block. Alternate pressing directions to avoid bulky seams!

Square block to 12 ¹/₂" (12" finished block).



This quilt was made using nine blocks set in a 3 x 3 grid. The finished size is 36" x 36".
