


## AMISH DIAMONDS


Color A	Bright solid	<ul> <li>(1) 6 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" square</li> <li>(4) 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 6 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" rectangles</li> </ul>
Color B	Black solid	<ul> <li>(8) 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" squares</li> <li>(mark 4 of these on the diagonal)</li> </ul>






Place a black  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square, right sides together, lined up with the upper left corner of the bright solid  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Mark the diagonal and sew in the direction shown. Trim off excess seam allowance and press the remainder

towards the center square corner. Now sew another  $3\frac{1}{2}$  black square to the opposing corner in the same way, and then to the two adjacent corners. Square to  $6\frac{1}{2}$ .



Piece the block as shown. Make rows first and then join rows to make the block. Alternate pressing directions to avoid bulky seams!

Square block to 12 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" (12" finished block).



This quilt was made using nine blocks set in a 3 x 3 grid. The finished size is 36" x 36".
