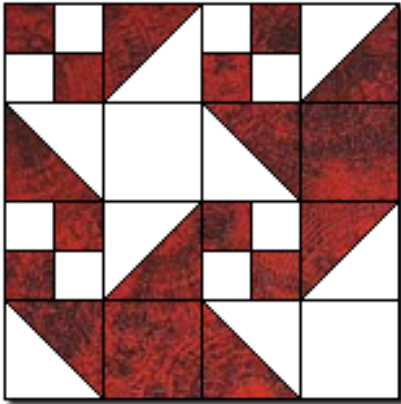

## Just Monkeying Around



Color 1 - Red/ Purple Batik

Two 3- 1/2" squares

One 2" x 20" strip

One 3-7/8" x 15-1/2" strip

Color 2- Background Beige

Two 3- 1/2" squares

One 2" x 20" strip

One 3-7/8" x 15-1/2" strip

1. Sew the Color 1 and Color 2 2" x 20" strips right sides together along one long edge, using a 1/4" seam. Press seam towards the darker side. Cut this unit at 2" intervals.
2. Sew pairs of the two color units together to make four patches. Press seam to one side. Make four units like this.
3. Stack the Color 1 and Color 2 3-7/8" squares right sides together and all edges aligned. On the back of the beige square, lightly mark the diagonals. Now sew a scant 1/4" above and below the marked diagonals. Cut apart on the marked diagonals between the rows of stitching. Press seams towards the darker sides. Trim to 3-1/2".
4. Make rows, pressing seams in alternating directions with each addition. Press alternate rows in the other direction. Assemble block.
