

September Churn-Dash Block 12" finished size (square to 12.5")

Cutting:

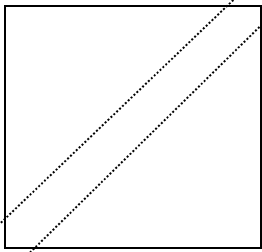


Light blue background fabric
2 squares 5" x 5"
1 square 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"
1 rectangle 2 1/2" x 20"

Novelty sewing small print churn-dash fabric
2 squares 5" x 5"
1 rectangle 2 1/2" x 20"

Make Four Half Square Triangles

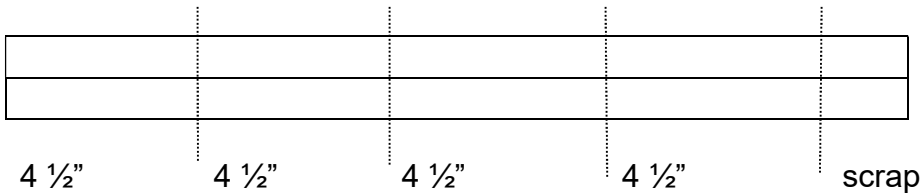
Use the two 5" squares of background fabric and the two 5" squares of churn-dash fabric
Use a ruler to mark 1/4" from each side of the center diagonal on the wrong side of the background fabric (or mark the center diagonal and sew 1/4" away on each side of your marked line)



Layer each square of background fabric with a square of churn dash fabric, right sides together.
Sew on marked lines.
Cut on center diagonal between stitched lines.
Press seam toward the darker fabric.
Square up to make four 4 1/2" half square triangle units

Strip pieced units

Use the 2 1/2"x 20-inch rectangles of background fabric and churn-dash fabric
Layer the fabric right sides together. Sew along the long edge.
Press seam toward the darker fabric.
Sub cut the strip into 4 squares 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"



Layout block to match illustration

Sew each row together.
Press seams toward the strip pieced units.
Pin at corners to match corner points.

Sew rows together to make the block.
