Materials needed for Half Square Log Cabin
Finished quilt measures 55” square

Sewing machine, mat, cutter, rulers – well stocked sewing basket.

A variety of fat quarters, lights, mediums and darks to make 36 blocks that finish 7” (there are 36 blocks in this quilt). 2 yards for lattice fabric
1 ¾ yards for borders

Half square triangles cut from 4 inch strips using the **nifty notions half square triangle ruler**
Cut size for strips is 1 ½”
Finished size of blocks with lattice is 7”



Materials needed for Star Quilt



anything in between for a total of 2 yards (yes, you can bring more)).

1. There are 8 stars in this small piece.
2. What Susan and I suggest is a variety of fat quarters. We have approximately 7 different fabrics so choose colors that you like.
3. For the background we chose a variety of lights fabric to make the piece more interesting. Bring to class a total of 2 yards of light fabric (try to avoid white on white) (i.e. 2 yards of the same fabric or 8 fat quarters or anything in between for a total of 2 yards (yes, you can bring more)).
4. You will need your regular quilting supplies, sewing machine, cutter and mat, pins, scissors, rulers etc.

You are an intelligent woman – bring to class whatever makes you comfortable so you can concentrate on sewing. Oops, I want to clarify one thing, no boom boxers or whatever they are called now.
