FOLDED FLOWER WALL HANGING

Alice Means is teaching a beautiful 24” wall hanging designed using several dimensional techniques. You will learn how to make a quilt block using dimensional curved patchwork, adding a tucked border, then a peek-a-boo border.

The **cost is \$25 for Clamshell Quilt Guild members and \$35 for non-members.**

Supplies needed:

Sewing machine, 18x24 cutting mat, rotary cutter, usual quilting supplies
Quarter inch foot attachment
Size 70/10 sharp needle (new)
Size 50 thread, neutral, and color to match Medium color fabric
Mini-iron and small pressing mat (helpful but not mandatory)

Fabric needed: (I used solid batiks since we’ll be sewing through many layers.)

Fat quarter light (off-white in sample)
Half yard medium (light green in sample)
Fat Quarter bright (pink in sample)
One yard dark (purple in sample)

Pre-cut instructions will be forwarded upon registration.
