## February: Crocus

Color A: Light/pale purple background: (2) 5" squares
(3) $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares
(1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square
(1) $4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle

Color B: Medium yellow print: (1) $21 / 2$ " square
Color C: Med/dark purple OR white print (choose one color): (1) 5" square

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\text { (1) } 41 / 2 " \text { square }
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Color D: Medium green print: (1) 5" square
1.) Match light purple and yellow $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares right sides together and sew a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam. Press open. Match this unit with light purple $41 / 2 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle right sides together, making sure that the light purple square is on the left. Sew a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam on long edge. Press open. (Refer to picture for placement.)

2.) Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the (2) 5 " light purple squares.
3.) Layer (1) 5 " light purple square right side together with (1) 5 " med. purple or white square. Sew $1 / 4$ ' on either side of the drawn line. Cut along drawn line and press open to make (2) units. Trim each unit to $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
4.) Layer (1) 5 " light purple square right side together with (1) 5 " green square. Sew $1 / 4$ ' on either side of the drawn line. Cut along drawn line and press open to make (2) units. Trim each unit to $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
5.) Arrange (9) $41 / 2$ " units into rows according to the diagram. Sew each horizontal row together with a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam. Pin rows together and sew with $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$. Press.
