February: Crocus

Color A: Light/pale purple background: (2) 5" squares

(3) 4 ½" squares

(1) 2 ½" square

(1) 4 ½" x 2 ½" rectangle

Color B: Medium yellow print: (1) 2 1/2" square

Color C: Med/dark purple OR white print (choose one color): (1) 5" square


Color D: Medium green print: (1) 5" square

1.) Match light purple and yellow 2 ½" squares right sides together and sew a ¼" seam. Press open. Match this unit with light purple 4 ½ x 2 ½" rectangle right sides together, making sure that the light purple square is on the left. Sew a ¼" seam on long edge. Press open. (Refer to picture for placement.)



- 2.) Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the (2) 5" light purple squares.
- 3.) Layer (1) 5" light purple square right side together with (1) 5" med. purple or white square. Sew 1/4" on either side of the drawn line. Cut along drawn line and press open to make (2) units. Trim each unit to 4 1/2".
- 4.) Layer (1) 5" light purple square right side together with (1) 5" green square. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ on either side of the drawn line. Cut along drawn line and press open to make (2) units. Trim each unit to 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".
- 5.) Arrange (9) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " units into rows according to the diagram. Sew each horizontal row together with a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam. Pin rows together and sew with $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press.
