## January - Winter Blues

## Light Blue

(2) 5 " squares

## Medium Blue

(2) $5^{\prime \prime}$ squares
(1) $21 / 2 " \times 5$ " strip
(1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ strip
(1) $21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}$ strip

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the light blue 5" squares. Match right sides together with medium blue $5^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on both sides of the marked line. Cut apart on pencil line, press open and trim to (4) $41 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

## Dark Blue

(1) $21 / 2 " \times 20$ " strip

Match light blue and dark blue $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20$ " strips, right sides together. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam on long edge. Press seam to darker fabric.

Sub cut (8) $21 / 2 "$ units. Set aside 2. With the remaining 6 , sew together (3) four patch squares.


Match light blue and medium blue $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5$ " strips, right sides together. Sew $1 / 4$ " seam on long edge. Press seam to darker fabric.


Sub cut (2) $21 / 2 "$ units, sew together with the two set aside in the previous step to make (2) four patch squares.


Arrange the (9) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ units as pictured below. Sew each row, pressing seams in alternative directions. Sew the three rows together to make a $121 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ block.
