January – Winter Blues

Light Blue

(2) 5" squares

(1) 2 ½" x 5" strip

(1) 2 ½" x 20" strip

Medium Blue

(2) 5" squares

(1) 2 ½" x 5" strip

Dark Blue

(1) 2 ½" X 20" strip

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the light blue 5" squares. Match right sides together with medium blue 5" squares. Sew 1/4" on both sides of the marked

line. Cut apart on pencil line, press open and trim to (4) 4 1/2" squares.

Match light blue and dark blue 2 ½" x 20" strips, right sides together. Sew ¼" seam on long edge. Press seam to darker fabric.

Sub cut (8) 2 1/2" units. Set aside 2. With the remaining 6, sew together (3) four patch squares.

Match light blue and medium blue 2 ½" x 5" strips, right sides together. Sew ¼" seam on long edge. Press seam to darker fabric.

Sub cut (2) 2 ½" units, sew together with the two set aside in the previous step to make (2) four patch squares.

Arrange the (9) 4 1/2" units as pictured below. Sew each row, pressing seams in alternative directions. Sew the three rows together to make a 12 ½" block.
