JUNE: Diamond Star

RED STAR:

Color A: red on red print, OR mainly red with white print: (2) 4x4" squares

(4) 3 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles

Color B: white on white print, OR white background with red print: (2) 4"x4" squares

(12) 3 ½" x 3 ½" squares

- 1.) Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the (2) white 4" squares. Match white 4" squares right sides together with (2) 4" red squares. Sew ¼" on either side of the drawn line. Cut along the drawn line, press open and trim each square to 3 ½". Will make 4 units.
- 2.) Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (8) 3 ½" white squares.
- 3.) Place a 3 ½" square and a 3 ½" x 6 ½" rectangle right sides together. (Refer to diagram for placement.) Sew ON the marked line. Cut off the excess seam allowance. Press to the darker color. Repeat this with another 3 ½" square on the other end of the rectangle. Repeat to make four units. Square these back to 3 ½" x 6 ½" if needed.




4.) Sew a 3 ½" white square to the left of a half-square triangle. Use a ½" seam. Make for units.



5.) Sew each half square/square unit to a rectangle, as shown below. Make four units.



6.) Arrange the quadrants according to the diagram and sew together with a 1/4" seam.
