

October - Pumpkin Patch

Color A: Brown
(5) 1 1/2" squares

Color B: Tan
(2) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles
(4) 2 1/2" squares
Plus more for inner patch

Color C: Orange
(1) 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangle
(2) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles
(2) 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles
Plus more for inner patch

First, choose which inner patch that you like best.



9 Patch

Tan (5) 2 1/2" squares
Orange (4) 2 1/2" squares.
Sew together as pictured.



Churn Dash

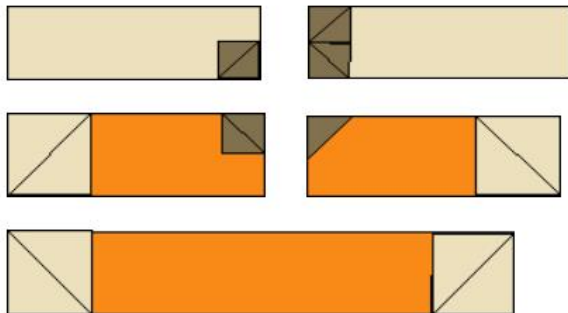
Tan (4) 2 1/2" squares
(2) 3" Squares
Orange (1) 2 1/2" square
(2) 3" Squares
Draw a diagonal line on Tan 3" squares. Wrong sides together with same size Orange, sew 1/4" on both sides of line, cut apart on marked line, press and trim to 2 1/2". Assemble as pictured.



Pinwheel

Tan (2) 4" Squares
Orange (2) 4" Squares
Draw a diagonal line on the back of Tan squares. With wrong sides together, Sew Tan and Orange 1/4" on both sides of the line, cut apart on marked line, press and trim to 3 1/2". Sew as pictured.

To complete the block, draw a diagonal line on the back of the brown squares and the 4 tan squares. Place on rectangles as follows:



Sew on marked line, trim leaving 1/4" seam.

Next sew the two tan 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles together with the brown triangles in the center. Repeat with the two orange rectangles of similar size.

Add an orange 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangle to each side of your chosen inner patch.

Assemble row by row to finish the block.
Press.
